GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS 2019

DHL EuroCup is a DHL Express event, created to cater to the certified international specialists within the European continent with an 'As One' and 'Can Do' spirit.

1. DHL entities from DHL Express Europe are welcome to participate with one football team and one cheerleading team, plus supporters, including a Country Coach and Senior Management Team (SMT), with a maximum of 66 members. Any exception is to be pre-approved by Tamas Lengyel at tamas.lengyel2@dhl.com. Please note: supporters can NOT replace football players or cheerleaders.

2. All country or entity organization is undertaken by a Country Coach. The Country Coach is responsible for communicating with the EuroCup Organizing Committee and his/her team members.

3. Country Coaches can appoint Football Coaches and Cheerleading Coaches. The name of the Country Football Coach and Country Cheerleading Coach needs to be sent to info@dhleurocup.com by 26th November 2018. Country Coaches should align with their Country/Entity Manager and HR department for relief and support for their role as Country Coach.

4. Country Coaches are responsible for running local activities and leading their respective countries pre and post event. Responsibilities also include budget, local activation plans and implementation, travel schedules and liaison with Football and Cheerleading Coaches. The Country Coach is the main representative and the person accountable for his/her respective country/entity.

5. During the EuroCup weekend, Country Coaches must be available to the Organizing Committee at all times.

6. Country Coaches are responsible for registering his/her respective team(s). All registration will be done via the EuroCup registration site. EuroCup registration will be open from 18th February 2019.

7. The approval of each single participant by the respective Country Manager and HR Head is mandatory.

8. The following registration dates and deadlines apply: Football & Cheerleading Coach names - 26th November 2018, Submit names for data approval - 8th March 2019, Registration of team - 15th April 2019, Provide travel details of all attendees - 29th April 2019.

9. All deadlines for requested information must be met. Any exception is to be pre-approved by Tamas Lengyel at tamas.lengyel2@dhl.com

10. The football competition is played according to FIFA rules, unless otherwise stated. It is the obligation of every participant to carefully read it and follow all the rules.
